Greater Essex Community Uplift Foundation

The Greater Essex Community Uplift Foundation (GECUF), a key strategic non-profit partner of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., Eta Pi Chapter, is dedicated to supporting the Greater Essex County Community and beyond. GECUF is a 501(c)(3) organization, located in the Omega Family Resource and Learning Center, 132 S. Harrison St., East Orange, NJ, 07018. The mission of GECUF is to ensure greater independence and empowerment of the surrounding communities via philanthropic, mentoring, and service oriented initiatives. Since its inception, GECUF has provided over \$450,000 in college scholarships to more than 250 deserving minority students. The following is a representation of other foundation initiatives:

- Established the Ernest Everett Just Mentoring Program which collaborates with several local school districts, and youth organizations serving over 200 students annually.
- Established a partnership with Princeton University's Blairstown Center to co-host annual overnight "Leadership Retreats" for male students ages 11yrs 18yrs
- Facilitates the Well Prepared Program, an obesity awareness initiative, with funding support from the National Institute on Minority Health and Health Disparities (NIMHD). The program has served over 200 students and families since 2020.
- Hosts the Annual Community Uplift 5K Fun Run & Walk Event during the month of May in East Orange, NJ
- Annual Thanksgiving Turkey Giveaway with accompaniments to as many as 300 families
- Provided grant money to the Black United Fund to support Health Initiatives
- Provided grants and professional support to establish an Annual Health Fair in Montclair, NJ
- Hosted a county-wide Health Fair for young children
- Donated hundreds of books and educational materials to Afterschool Educational Programs in East Orange, New Jersey

- Host an annual county-wide Talent Hunt for High School Students, providing an outlet for them to display their talents and provided travel expenses to the winner for their participation in the next level of competition.
- Provided gifts and services for Easter Egg Hunts held in Orange and East Orange
- Provided grants to purchase gifts for needy children and families during the Holiday Season
- Established an Afterschool Enrichment Program for area youth including a Gaming Cafe at the Omega Family Resource and Learning Center

The Greater Essex Community Uplift Foundation is supported by the men of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., Eta Pi Chapter. We have been mentored and shaped by the Omega pillars of the past and firmly believe that we are 'My Brother's Keeper'. Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. is an international fraternity with over 750 undergraduate and graduate chapters. The Fraternity was founded on November 17, 1911, by three Howard University undergraduate students and their faculty adviser. Omega Psi Phi is the first predominantly African-American fraternity to be founded at a historically black college and university (HBCU).

Eta Pi Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Inc. was chartered in 1973 in Montclair, New Jersey. The Chapter, comprised of college-educated men, has been a steadfast pillar of the community for more than 40 years providing community programming such as economic empowerment seminars; voter education workshops; clothing, food, and toy drives; mentoring programs; and career exploration activities including college fairs and talent showcases.







Legacy Park

The Ambrose Ward Mansion at 132 South Harrison Street, East Orange, New Jersey, now owned by the African-American Fund of New Jersey, is listed on both the State of New Jersey and National Registers of Historic Places. The Ambrose Ward Mansion was commissioned to be built by the Vanderbilt family and the building was completed in 1896. The design is Roman Renaissance and appears to have been adopted from McKim, Mead and White's Villard Houses constructed fifteen years earlier on Madison Avenue in New York City, located behind St. Patrick's Cathedral.

The property is the lone survivor of a row of fashionable mansions that once lined South Harrison Street, which at one time was known as Mansion Row. This property once extended from South Harrison Street eastward to Evergreen Place and now measures 185.78 feet by 284 feet. The interior of the facility features 12,500 sq. ft. of operable space on three floors.

Legacy Park, will feature a Legacy Walk where you can pay tribute to and recognize people, events, and dates – a place where you can purchase a brick of your choice and affirm a legacy.

The Legacy Walk will consist of bricks and pavers leading up to the front of the grand porch of the Ambrose Ward Mansion and will also encompass the walking path along the front edge of the main entrance.


